



Spring Tune-Up Tips

- Your mower needs periodic maintenance to run safely and correctly. Make sure you give it a spring tune-up every year.
- Refer to your operator's manual for routine maintenance schedules that suggest when to sharpen your mower blade and when to change your oil, oil filters, fuel and air filters.
- It is recommended that you:
 - Change the oil after 25 hours of mowing, which is usually once a year. Therefore, it is good to change the oil and filters every spring.
 - Put fresh gas in your mower every spring.
 - Replace spark plugs annually.
 - Keep fans and intake screens clear.
 - Make sure all safety shields and switches are working correctly.

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
